Through the CDF- Pakistan Legal Aid Forum free legal aid is provided for women victims of crimes.

The recently formed Sports Club has succeeded in realizing the potential of young people who would have otherwise been outcasts in their communities. CDF- Pakistan activities continue to be concentrated in three diverse areas of Pakistan.

The CDF- Pakistan really does make a difference to people's lives, and I get quite a buzz out of being part of it. Time and time again I have come across young women and children of all faiths who have received training in the CDF- Pakistan Skill Centers over the past Twenty years, and who are now making a living for themselves and their families, bringing home up to Rs6000 per month – a very respectable sum in the rural desert communities. Some have become trainers themselves, and so this is an example of the Project becoming self-sustaining.

The CDF- Pakistan Schools also have provided a lifeline for uneducated communities in Sindh; they are a credit to the dogged determination of the CDF- Pakistan team to improve opportunities in these impoverished communities. So, to conclude, the CDF- Pakistan is demonstrably improving the quality of life for women, children, families and communities. 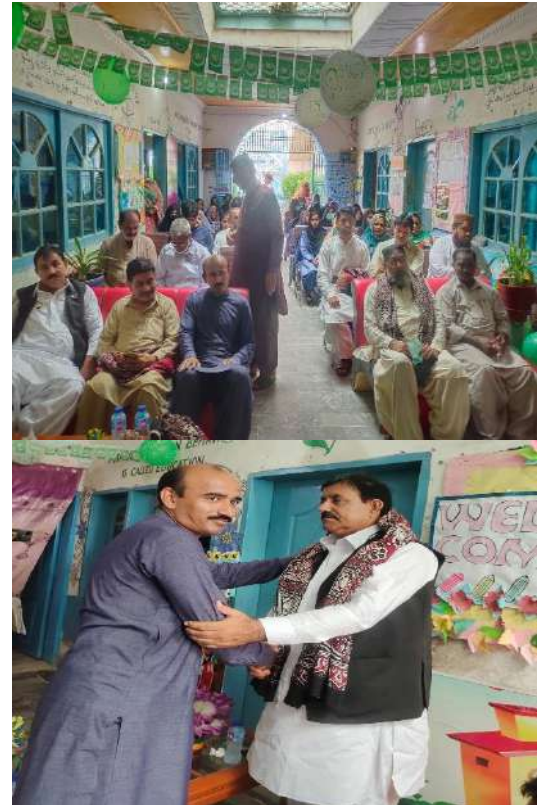
## IMPORTANCE OF GIRLS EDUCATION
